DIRECTIONS: (For those using a GPS System. please use Cove Street in East Haven)

From Interstate 95 (Connecticut Turnpike Traveling Northbound (from Bridgeport): Get off at Exit 50. At 3rd traffic light go right onto Townsend Avenue. Follow Townsend Ave. to 2nd traffic light. Go right onto Lighthouse Road. Follow Lighthouse Road to the 5th right (Rhea Street). Go straight ahead to Amarante's.

From Interstate 95 (Connecticut Turnpike) Traveling Southbound on Interstate 95 (from Branford/Guilford): Get off at Exit 51. Go to 3rd traffic light, turn left onto Townsend Ave. Follow Townsend Ave. to 3rd traffic light. Go right onto Lighthouse Road. Follow Lighthouse Road to the 5th right (Rhea Street). Go straight ahead to Amarante's.

PROGRAM: The following Meritorious Service Awards will be presented: (1) Det. Sgt. Joseph Flynn of Clinton Police Department for leading the investigation that led to the arrest and subsequent conviction of Dr. Tory Westbrook on multiple counts of sexual assault. He went to great lengths to ensure that the women did not know about each other. **(2)** Officer Jorge Romero of Ridgefield Police Department, who was dispatched to investigate a domestic violence complaint; he acted with strength, poise and bravery when faced with a gun pointed at him at a distance of 3 to 5 feet, and ultimately fatally shot the male. **(3)** Sergeant Christopher Fry, Officer Margaret Smusz, Officer John-Paul Dorais, Officer Mark Nowak and Officer Christopher Owen of Meriden Police Department responded to a fire at a condominium complex, without hesitation and with no safety equipment, systematically searched and evacuated residents who were still in their units, two of whom were wheelchair-bound, prior to the arrival of fire personnel.
