DIRECTIONS: From Route 15 (Merritt Pkwy/Wilbur Cross Pkwy): Take exit 56 from north or south. Turn right onto Route 121 (Grassy Hill Rd). Travel 1-1/2 miles, turn left onto Clark Lane. Entrance is on left. From Interstate 95 (Connecticut Turnpike): Take exit 39A. Heading north, turn right onto Route 1 (Boston Post Rd). Heading south, exit 39A merges into Route 1 (Boston Post Rd). Stay to the right, 3rd traffic light after Friendly's Restaurant, turn right onto Route 121 (North St). Travel 2-1/2 miles, turn right onto Clark Lane. Entrance is on left. From Route 8: Take exit 15. Turn right off ramp, go to 2nd traffic light, turn right onto Route 34 (Derby Ave/New Haven Ave). Travel 2 miles, turn right onto Route 121 (Grassy Hill Rd). Travel 3 miles, turn left onto Clark Lane. Entrance is on left.

PROGRAM: 3 Meritorious Service Awards will be presented: (1) John and Bidy Roger from New Milford; John was a commissioner for 8 years in New Milford, and they ran Loaves and Fishes soup kitchen for 27 yrs. (2) Officer John Ley, a 14 year veteran of Norwich PD. On January 7, 2013, Officer Ley and other Norwich officers were fired upon as they responded to a report of an armed suicidal man. Officer Ley was shot 4 times, and seriously wounded with injuries to his neck, shoulder, and leg. (3) Off-duty Stamford firefighter Tom Elles, and citizen Matt Walker of Norwalk. On 10/27/12, these 2 good Samaritans dove into the frigid water in attempt to rescue the occupants before firefighters and police arrived on the scene. Reportedly, the husband was teaching his wife to drive and she lost control of the car.

ALSO THIS EVENING: The top 3 graduates from P.O.S.T. will be honored. They are: Peter Schmitt of Greenwich, Erin Connole of Avon, and Alexander Milne of Southington. Each of these fine officers will be given an engraved firearm from the Sturm, Ruger Company, Inc.
